

#### General Rules

- 1. Each competitor must enter into one primary class.
- 2. Each competitor must have signed the dated the entry form for ploughing.
- 3. All ploughing rules, scoring and penalties are as per the latest 'Official Rules for Ploughing' issued by The Society of Ploughmen Limited.
- 4. All ploughing to commence at 0900 and be completed by 1300.
- 5. If there are insufficient entries to a class, it will be suspended for that ploughing match, or if appropriate, merged with a compatible class.

#### County Novice Rules

Open to any competitor at a District Ploughing Match who has never won a first prize in any ploughing class at any ploughing match.

Any Competitor wishing to be judged for the Novice Championship must indicate on the entry form for the District Ploughing Match that he or she is eligible.

1st prize, £100 2nd price, £50 3rd prize, £25

- 1. Entry to the County Novice Championship will be via the relevant District Ploughing Match entry form and will be limited to reversible classes. Each competitor must have signed the dated the entry form for ploughing.
- 2. A novice is defined as someone who has never won a Class, including a Young Farmers Class or Novice Championship, at any ploughing match. However, winning a class in a Ploughing Match held after 1st September 2025 would not debar the competitor from entering the County Novice Championship.
- 3. Each District will identify the novices at their Ploughing Match that have entered the County Novice Championship: the County Judge will then award points to each of the competitors based on their finished work.
- 4. On completion of all the District Ploughing Matches the County Judge will rank all competitors based on the number of points he has awarded at the individual District Matches, prizes will be awarded to competitors ranked 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- 5. A competitor may enter the County Novice Championship as many times as he or she wishes by entering more than one District Ploughing Match.
- 6. Competitors must live within the County of Staffordshire or within 10 miles of the County Boundary

For the best ploughing using a tractor and reversible plough.

#### Class 2. The Jack Harvey Cup: Staffordshire Championship Class

For the best ploughing using a tractor and reversible plough.

#### Class 3. The Philip H. Collier Salver: Stafford District Class

For the best ploughing by a Stafford District Member or employee using a tractor and reversible plough.

#### Class 4. Classic Mounted Reversible

For the best ploughing using a classic tractor and reversible mounted plough, eligibility according to SOP rules.

#### Class 5. Classic Mounted Conventional

For the best ploughing using a classic tractor and conventional mounted plough, eligibility according to SOP rules.

#### Class 6. Chase Fuels Trophy: Staffordshire Championship Class

For the best ploughing using a vintage tractor and trailed plough, eligibility according to SOP rules.

#### Class 7. The Tom Tavernor Challenge Cup

For the best ploughing using a vintage tractor and hydraulic mounted plough, eligibility according to SOP rules.

#### Class 8. The Neil McCulloch Challenge Cup

For the best ploughing using a vintage tractor and hydraulic mounted plough, eligibility according to SOP rules. Competitors not to have been placed in classes 7 or 8 at the Stafford Ploughing match during the last 3 Years.

#### Class 9. Ferguson Ploughing Class

For the best ploughing using a vintage Ferguson tractor and mounted plough, eligibility according to SOP rules.

### Secondary Classes

#### Class 10. The DG Williams Memorial Trophy

For the best ploughing by a competitor aged under 20 on the day. 1st prize £25, 2nd prize £10.

#### Class 11. N.G. White Cup

For the best ploughing by a competitor aged under 28 on the day. 1st prize £25, 2nd prize £10.

#### Class 12. The Alan Stubbs Trophy

For the best ploughing using a four furrow or larger, reversible plough.

#### Class 13. J.R. Brandon Memorial Prizes

For the best cop in classes 5-9, £10. For the best rein in classes 5-9, £10.

#### Class 14. A.G. Parrott & R.P. Collier Prizes

For the best turnout in classes 4-9. 1st prize £25, 2nd prize £10.

#### Class 15. The John Brandon Memorial Salver

For the best ploughing using a Ferguson tractor in classes 4-9.

#### Class 16. The Stafford District Vintage Ploughing Cup

For the best ploughing in classes 4-9.

#### Class 17. The Stafford District Challenge Cup


For the best ploughing in classes 1-3 by a Stafford District Member or employee.
